Channel District Improvements Project

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Construction of the N. 11th Street Improvements (Phase E2) of the Channel District Improvements Project is scheduled to begin on Monday, February 7, 2022. This construction project will include roadway and water infrastructure improvements, along with new sidewalk, landscaping, and irrigation. During the first phase of construction on N. 11th Street (Phase E2), the northbound travel lane will be closed between E. Whiting Street and E. Washington Street between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. All on-street parking spaces on the east side of N. 11th Street will be closed for approximately 2 weeks. The southbound travel lane will remain open with

intermediate flagging operations. Both lanes of traffic will reopen daily at the end of business and close again the following morning. Construction will progress as follows:

- The northbound travel lane on N. 11th Street between E. Whiting Street and E. Washington Street will be temporarily closed to motorists and pedestrians for 2 weeks. Sidewalks and ingress/egress will remain open with minor interruptions to allow for the waterline to be installed in this area. During this time, the southbound travel lane will remain open to traffic.
- Following completion of the waterline installation within the northbound travel lane, the improvements on E. Whiting Street between Meridian Ave and N. 11th Street will be completed and the intersection of E. Whiting Street and N. 11th Street will be reopened. Restoration of the intersection for traffic is scheduled for mid-summer of 2022.

While we make these improvements to our community, please exercise caution in and around the construction area. Bicyclists, pedestrians, and drivers should:

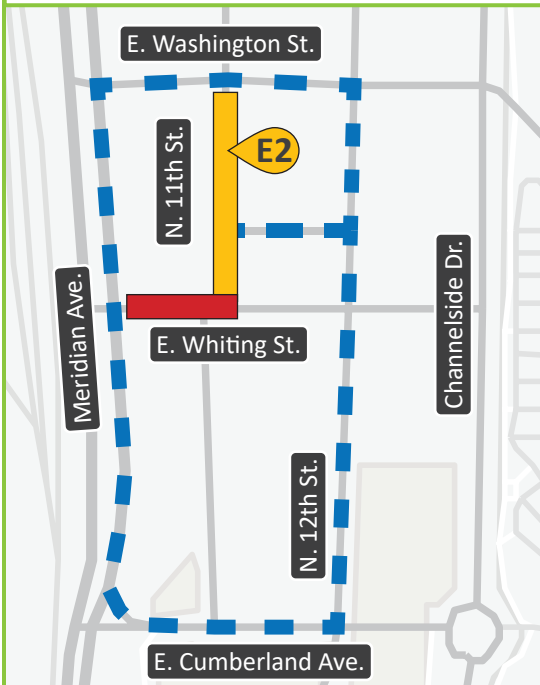
- Avoid crossing through the construction zone

- Wait for flaggers to signal that it is safe to proceed through the work zone
